The Greystones Sailing Club "Taste Of Greystones" Cruiser Regatta will be held at Greystones Sailing Club, Sunday Aug 30th 2015 .

1.0 ORGANISING AUTHORITY

2.0 RULES AND ELIGIBILITY

2.1 The Regatta will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2013 - 2016 (RRS), the prescriptions of the Irish Sailing Association (ISA), the ISA ECHO Performance Handicap System, the ISAF/ORC Safety Regulations Category 4, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions and any amendments thereto.

2.2 Entries are accepted at the sole discretion of the Organising Committee.

3.0 DIVISIONS/CLASSES

3.1 Boats will be divided as follows on the basis of their ISA ECHO

3.2 Racing will be run under the progressive Echo handicap .

3.3 The applicable starting handicap will be your **current club echo** but limited to 3% +/- the boats standard Echo handicap , This is extended to 5%+/- for bilge keel boats. This recognises differing sailing abilities but limits the extremities of club handicaps.

ECHO Class I Ratings of 0.990 and above

ECHO Class II Ratings of 0.915 – 0.989

ECHO Class III Ratings 0.915 and below

ECHO Class IV White Sails Fleet – No Spinnaker

(subject to the Race Committee's right to allocate a boat to any Class).

One design classes will be scored for both echo and class where 4 or more boats from that class are entered.

Additionally 3 IRC trophies will be awarded for boats producing IRC cert 48 hrs before start , Starting order will remain as per above Echo bands.

The Handicap Bands for the Classes are provisional, and may be subject to change by the Race Committee up to 2 hours before Race 1, to provide an even spread of boats in the Classes.

The cruisers class 3 East Coast championships will be run concurrently in Greystones on Sat 29th and Sun 30th . Separate NOR will be issued by the Class 3 association but all class 3 boats are encouraged to enter . As part of the Taste Of Greystones regatta there will be a team prize for teams of 3 Class 3 boats subject to a separate entry form issued by the Cruisers Class 3 association and available at registration. The teams do not have to be from the one club.

SCHEDULE OF RACES

4.1 The schedule of races will be as follows:

Race 1 Sunday August 30th Warning signal at 10.55am

Two races will be held on Sunday Aug 30th 2015

A target time of 2.30pm for completion of two race series has been set and prize giving is targeted for 3.30pm to allow visiting boats reasonable departure time.

The Organising Authority reserves the right to amend the Schedule of Races

4.0 SCORING

The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A of the RRS will apply. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series. When all races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her 2 race scores.

6.0 ENTRIES

Entries shall be made by completing the entry form and returning the form to Greystones Sailing Club. Entries are accepted at the sole discretion of the Organising Authority.

Entry Fees: Class I: €50.00 Class II: €50.00 Class III: €50.00 White Sails €50.00

Entry includes Free marina , Complimentary drink voucher for sailing club and Beach House plus complimentary lunch courtesy of Greystones Harbour Marina and BJ Marine .

7.0 SAIL NUMBERS

Each boat shall show a distinguishing number on each side of its mainsail, which shall be the same number as declared on the Entry Form.

8.0 HANDICAPS

ECHO handicaps will be published on the official notice board outside the race office not later than 09.00 Hrs. on Sunday Aug 30th. Subsequent revisions following Race 1 may be displayed on the official notice board.

9.0 PRIZES/TROPHIES

Prizes will be awarded in each Class and will consist of 2nd , 3rd and overall prizes and trophies.

Prizes will be awarded to all clubs holding confirmed feeder races on the Saturday with Feeder race prizegiving in Greystones sailing Club 19.00 Sat Aug 29th .

10.0 REGISTRATION AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

All entrants shall register with the Race Office in Marina management offices upon arrival. Sailing Instructions , Race card , Vouchers and Visitor Information will be available on registration and may be posted on the website prior to the event. The Pre-Event Race Office hours are:

Saturday August 29st 15.00hrs – 20.00 hrs

Sunday August 30th 08.30 hrs - 10.00 hrs

It is important to register early to allow clarity of all boats handicaps.

11.0 RACING AREA

Races will be sailed in Greystones area, South of Bray Head and North of Breeches Mark.

12.0 BERTHING

Entry includes free overnight berth in Greystones marina Saturday August 29th. Early entry is strongly encourage to assist in the management of an expected large fleet. Only boats actually racing on Sunday qualify for the complementary regatta berth. . Please radio Marina or call Marina office on 086 2718161 on approach.
