GSC Junior Code of Conduct

As a junior sailor participating in Club sailing and training at Greystones Sailing Club I understand that I am a valued member but, as I am not the only one, I will:

- Show **respect** for Club property and the property of others
- Show **respect** to fellow sailors, instructors and volunteers helping to run racing, sailing and events
- Ensure I am familiar with all **Club policies**
- **Obey** all race officials and instructors' directions, event rules on and off the water and Club rules.
- Attend each day on time and **participate** fully
- Dress appropriately: i.e. **wetsuits**, booties, buoyancy aid and kag

I will never:

- Steal, use or remove any gear that does not belong to me.
- Break laws relating to alcohol, non-prescribed drugs and tobacco.
- Cheat, bully, spread rumours, name-call or exclude others.

As a Sailor I am entitled to:

- Participate on an equal basis.
- Be treated with dignity.
- Be **happy, have fun and enjoy** the Club both on the water and ashore.

I understand that if it is found that any junior has not followed the above guidelines the following actions may be pursued:

1. A warning.

Notes to Parents and trainees.

You will find below details on what is required of the children **and** their parents while on the Cara na Mara Sailing Course at Greystones Sailing Club this summer. All trainees must wear a wetsuit, dinghy boots, buoyancy aid (life jacket), waterproof spray top (kag). The club can provide a limited number of kag/spray top or buoyancy aids to older/bigger course participants.

Bring plenty of **warm dry clothing** when on land.

The courses run from **9.30am to 12.30pm** and from **2pm to 5pm Monday to Friday**. There will be days when weather conditions will prevent some or all trainees going on the water. This cannot be avoided and shore-based activities will be organised in lieu.

Shore Parents:

There will be an employed and vetted shore parent for the duration of the course.

Medical issues or learning difficulties: It is imperative for the safety of your child, other trainees and instructors on the course that GSC is made aware of any issues your child may have. Any declaration will be treated in the strictest confidence and shared only on a 'need to know' basis.

Concerns:

Should your child be having any issues at all in anticipation of, or while on the course, please let us know as soon as you are made aware so that we may address their concerns early and ensure they are having fun.

Open for Coffee:

To ensure you have the opportunity to meet other parents, see how the course is run and have a glimpse into what so exhausts your children, we will invite you join us for a cuppa and a scone during the course. You are also welcome in the Club to **Try Sailing** in May, for one of the **Adult Training Courses** throughout the summer or just for a natter in the bar after sailing on Wednesday evenings, Saturday afternoons and Sunday mornings.
