Junior Sailing Courses – Cancellation Policy

Greystones Sailing Club aims to run its courses in a safe, well-organised manner while being fair to families and protecting the viability of our programmes.

Participant Cancellations

- Cancellations **more than 14 days before** the course start date may receive a **50% refund. No course credit will be issued.**
- Cancellations **within 14 days** of the course start date are **non-refundable**, unless the place can be filled from the waiting list.
- Where a place is filled from the waiting list, a **refund may be issued at the Club's discretion.**

Medical or Exceptional Circumstances

- In cases of illness or injury, supported by a **medical certificate**, Greystones Sailing Club may offer a **partial refund** at its discretion.
- Each case will be reviewed individually.

Club Cancellations

- If a course is cancelled by Greystones Sailing Club due to safety concerns, instructor availability, or insufficient participant numbers, participants will be offered a **full refund** or the option to transfer to another suitable course.

Weather Conditions

- Sailing courses operate in a wide range of weather conditions and will not be cancelled due to rain or cold weather.
- If conditions are unsafe for sailing, **shore-based activities** will be provided where possible.
- No refunds will be issued due to weather unless the course is cancelled by the Club.

Behaviour and Safeguarding

- Greystones Sailing Club reserves the right to remove a participant whose behaviour breaches the Club's Code of Conduct or poses a risk to themselves or others.
- No refund will be issued in such circumstances.
